SAE Reporting System Transition – AdEERS to CTEP-AERS

This is a reminder that AdEERS is retiring and CTEP-AERS has taken its place. CTEP-AERS will be required for use in place of AdEERS on March 1, 2014.

Please note, any amendments to AdEERS reports <u>can and should</u> be done in CTEP-AERS. If a report was just initiated in AdEERS, it should be finished in AdEERS all the way through to Submission to NCI. Any **new** reports or amendments should be done in CTEP-AERS. CTEP-AERS contains AdEERS report information going back five years.
