MEMORANDUM

SWOG Biospecimen Bank (Lab #200 and Lab #201) Holiday

The SWOG Biospecimen Bank (Solid Tissue, Myeloma, and Lymphoma Division, Lab# 201) will be closed on Wednesday, July 4, 2018 in observance of Independence Day. Please store any specimens collected Tuesday, July 3rd according to protocol instructions and ship on Thursday, July 5th. Specimens that don't need to be sent overnight (i.e., slides or paraffin blocks) may be sent as usual.

Avoid sending large batch shipments of any type during the holiday week. Please hold large batches of specimens and ship the week following the holiday.

For BM specimens collected on S1702, if a specimen is collected on Tuesday, July 3rd, ship on Tuesday via FedEx Priority Overnight to arrive in our lab on Thursday. Since specimens will be in transit an extra day, please include a cold (not frozen) pack with the blood and/or bone marrow specimens. If a specimen is collected on Wednesday, July 4th, store the specimen at 4°C (in a refrigerator) until it can be shipped on Thursday, July 5th.

Please contact the Bank at (614-722-2866 or mglab@nationwidechildrens.org) before shipping BM specimens that will arrive on Thursday.

The SWOG Biospecimen Bank - Leukemia Division (Lab# 200) will be closed on Wednesday, July 4, 2018 in observance of Independence Day.

If a specimen is collected on Tuesday, July 3rd, ship on Tuesday via FedEx Priority Overnight to arrive in our lab on Thursday. Since specimens will be in transit an extra day, please include a cold (not frozen) pack with the blood and/or bone marrow specimens. If a specimen is collected on Wednesday, July 4th, store the specimen at 4°C (in a refrigerator) until it can be shipped on Thursday, July 5th.
