RE: Holiday Closures for SWOG Biospecimen Banks

MEMORANDUM

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform sites of the holiday closures for the SWOG Biospecimen Banks. Please note the following closures and instructions:

The SWOG Biospecimen Bank (Solid Tissue, Myeloma, and Lymphoma Division, Lab #201)

The SWOG Biospecimen Bank (Solid Tissue, Myeloma, and Lymphoma Division, Lab #201) will be closed on Monday, September 6th, 2021 for Labor Day.

If a surgery is scheduled for Monday, September 6th, please store frozen tissue according to protocol instructions until tissue can be sent on Tuesday, September 7th. If frozen specimens are collected on Friday or over the holiday weekend, please store them according to protocol instructions and ship Tuesday. Specimens that do not need to be sent via overnight courier service (e.g. slides or paraffin blocks) may be sent as usual.

The SWOG Biospecimen Bank will be open Saturday, September 4th to receive and process ambient **whole blood, bone marrow, and urine** only. Select "Saturday Delivery" and use the Priority Overnight service when creating a FedEx air bill. Please do not ship frozen specimens or paraffin-embedded tissue for Saturday delivery.

Avoid sending large batch shipments of any type during the week prior to the holiday. Please hold large batches of specimens and ship to the Bank on or after September 7th.

Before shipping myeloma samples, please email MGLab@nationwidechildrens.org and provide the tracking number.

SWOG Biospecimen Bank – Leukemia Division (Lab #200)

The SWOG Biospecimen Bank - Leukemia Division (Lab #200) will be closed on Monday, September 6th, 2021 for Labor Day.

The laboratory will be open to process specimens on Saturday, September 4th. If specimens are collected on Friday, please ship them via FedEx Priority Overnight. When shipping on Friday, please check *Saturday Delivery* on the FedEx air bill. Remember to contact the Bank (614-722-3270 or MGLab@nationwidechildrens.org) and provide the FedEx tracking number before shipping specimens that will arrive on Saturday.

If specimens are collected over the holiday weekend, please store them according to protocol instructions and ship on Tuesday, September 7th.
