Effective October 1, 2006, the responsibility for the Solid Tumor Specimen Repository for the Southwest Oncology Group will be moving from the University of Cincinnati to the University of Colorado – under the direction of Dr. Wilbur Franklin. Also, effective October 1, 2006, the responsibility for the Myeloma Specimen Repository for the Southwest Oncology Group will be moving from the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences to the University of Arizona – under the direction of Dr. Lisa Rimsza. The Myeloma Specimen Repository will now be housed in the same institution as the Lymphoma Specimen Repository.

Protocol updates will be provided to you over the next few Group mailings, but please begin using these new submission addresses as of October 1st. These changes will also be made in the online Specimen Tracking system on October 1st. Therefore correct shipping addresses will be available from the online Specimen Tracking system after this change.
