This has been necessary due to the different structural design of the OPEN patient registration	

system from the SWOG registration system.

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process, we want to ensure that Group participating members are able to register patients with minimal delay using OPEN. Therefore, it will be essential that all enrolling investigators are linked to their individual treating location(s) within RSS. It will <u>not</u> be required to link all investigators on your SWOG roster to a treatment site in RSS. This change will only affect your investigators who actively enroll patients to Group and Group-endorsed trials.

With more than a dozen SWOG protocols now utilizing the OPEN system for the enrollment
